Recruit a foster family to work with SCD (application can be found on website [www.secondchancedogs.net](http://www.secondchancedogs.net))

Transport your dog to a SCD location for assessment

Increase daily activity & socialization opportunities for your dog

Post biography of your dog on <http://www.rescueme.org/>; DO NOT POST your dog on Craig's List

Contact trainers for prices and descriptions of their training approaches. The dog's needs require your expertise to find the right fit.
